

## The tags you'll use most often

<b>&lt;html&gt;</b>	Goes around the entire page
<b>&lt;head&gt;</b>	The top section of the <html> page that contains information important to the file that isn't shown
<b>&lt;style&gt;</b>	A place you can put CSS
<b>&lt;body&gt;</b>	Where all the visual pieces of the site go. Also the tag you target to change the background of the page
<b>&lt;p&gt;</b>	Paragraph
<b>&lt;h1&gt;</b>	Most important headline
<b>&lt;h2&gt;</b>	Subheadline
<b>&lt;h3&gt;,&lt;h4&gt;...</b>	Sub-sub-headline
<b>&lt;a&gt;</b>	A link you can click
<b>&lt;em&gt;</b>	Italicizes text (emphasis)
<b>&lt;strong&gt;</b>	Bolds text (strong emphasis)
<b>&lt;ol&gt;</b>	Ordered list
<b>&lt;ul&gt;</b>	Unordered list
<b>&lt;li&gt;</b>	Goes around "list items" within <ol> or <ul>
<b>&lt;img /&gt;</b>	Shows an image, a "self contained" tag that closes itself
<b>&lt;div&gt;</b>	A section of content. More on this later...
